## Sierra Nevada Tree Mortality



# RCPP CRISIS TO OPPORTU STERRA NEVADA TREE MORTA

- Financial assistance available for forest health practices on nonindustrial private land
- Required: at least 1 dead or dying conifer tree due to bark beetle and/ or drought
- RCPP program allows for incentive payments within the defensible space for forestland homes
